

RED FOXES

How many little red foxes have you seen on the course this summer? Do you know where their den is? According to Ernie Baker, there are 6 kits and one Mom. They live in a den in the woodpile between # 2 tee and # 3 green. Their favorite place to play is next to # 1 green. You can often see them roaming around looking for rodents to eat.

According to Wikipedia, red foxes establish home ranges within particular areas. They use their urine to mark their territory. Red foxes reproduce once a year in the spring, with a gestational period from 49-58 days. The average litter is 4-6 kits, though up to 13 have occurred. Red foxes are usually together in pairs, as you can see in this photo taken by Kevin Keenan, or small groups consisting of families.
